

# **Covid-19 safety guidelines BAK, basis voor actuele kunst, Utrecht**

(from 17 February 2022)

In order to make your visit at BAK as safe and pleasant as possible, BAK has drafted the following Covid-19 safety guidelines according to the measures announced by the Dutch government

## **To keep in mind before you visit BAK:**

- If you show any Covid-19 related symptoms, such as a cold, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, a light cough, or high temperature (from 38 C°), please make sure to stay at home. If you pre-booked a ticket for a program at BAK, please let us know you are not coming so we can free up your seat(s).
- During regular opening hours, it is not necessary to pre-book tickets for an exhibition visit. You can buy a ticket at the door.
- It is required to show a "Coronatoegangsbewijs" (Corona entry pass) when you visit a program or exhibition at BAK. This is an official proof of vaccination, recovery, or a negative test result. You can present this proof via a QR-code in the CoronaCheck app, or via a printed version from [CoronaCheck.nl/print](https://www.coronacheck.nl/print). Please also bring along a valid ID. Your negative test result is valid for 24 hours. More information about the "Coronatoegangsbewijs" can be found [here](#) on the website of the Dutch Government.
- Payment at BAK is pin-only.

## **During your visit:**

- Please disinfect your hands with the disinfectant provided near the entrance.
- If you grab a copy of any printed material, please keep it with you.
- Cough and sneeze in the inside of your elbow. Use paper towels and dispose of them after use.
- There are two guest toilets at BAK. Please wash your hands with soap after visiting the bathroom.
- Please follow the directions of the BAK staff at all times.
